

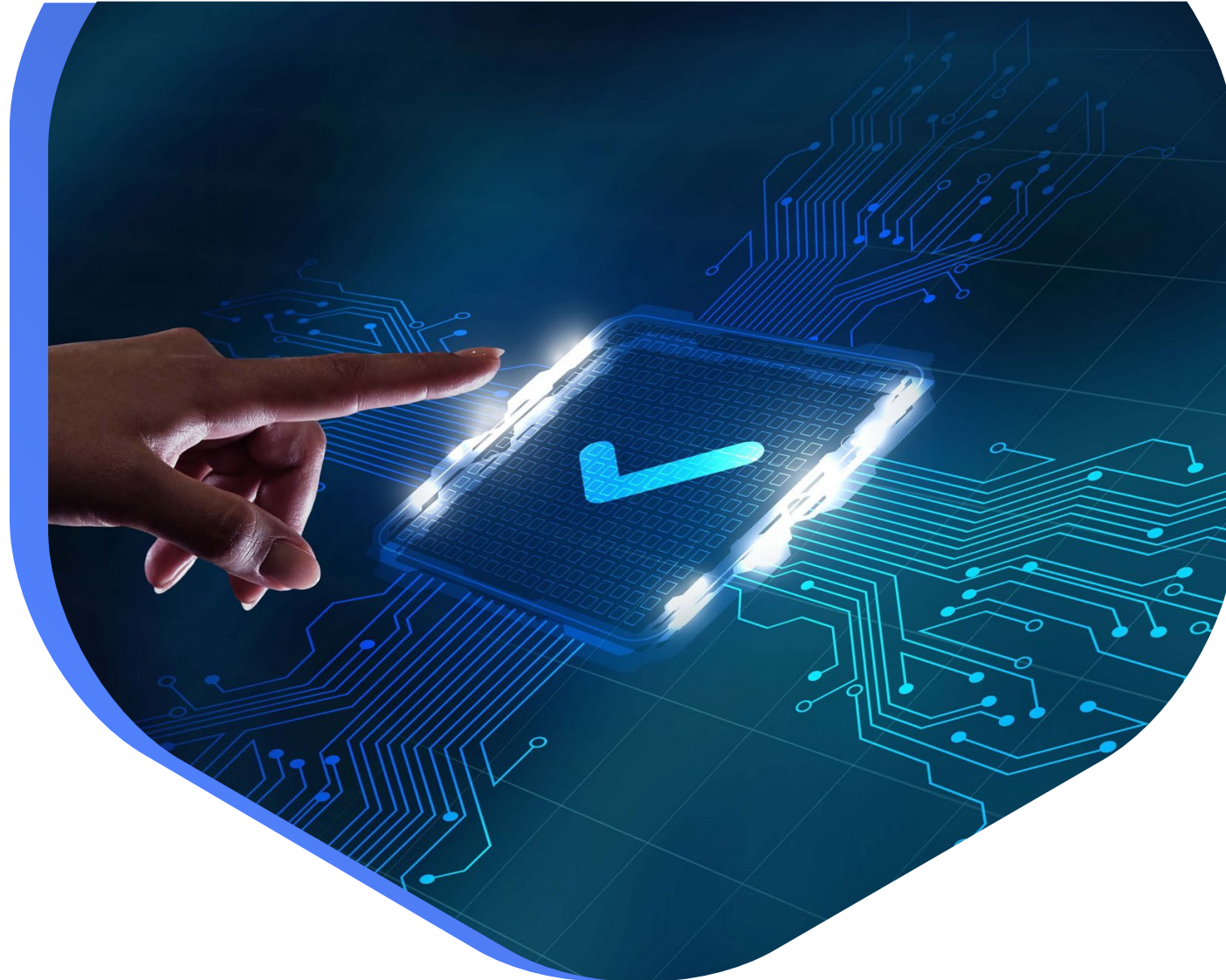

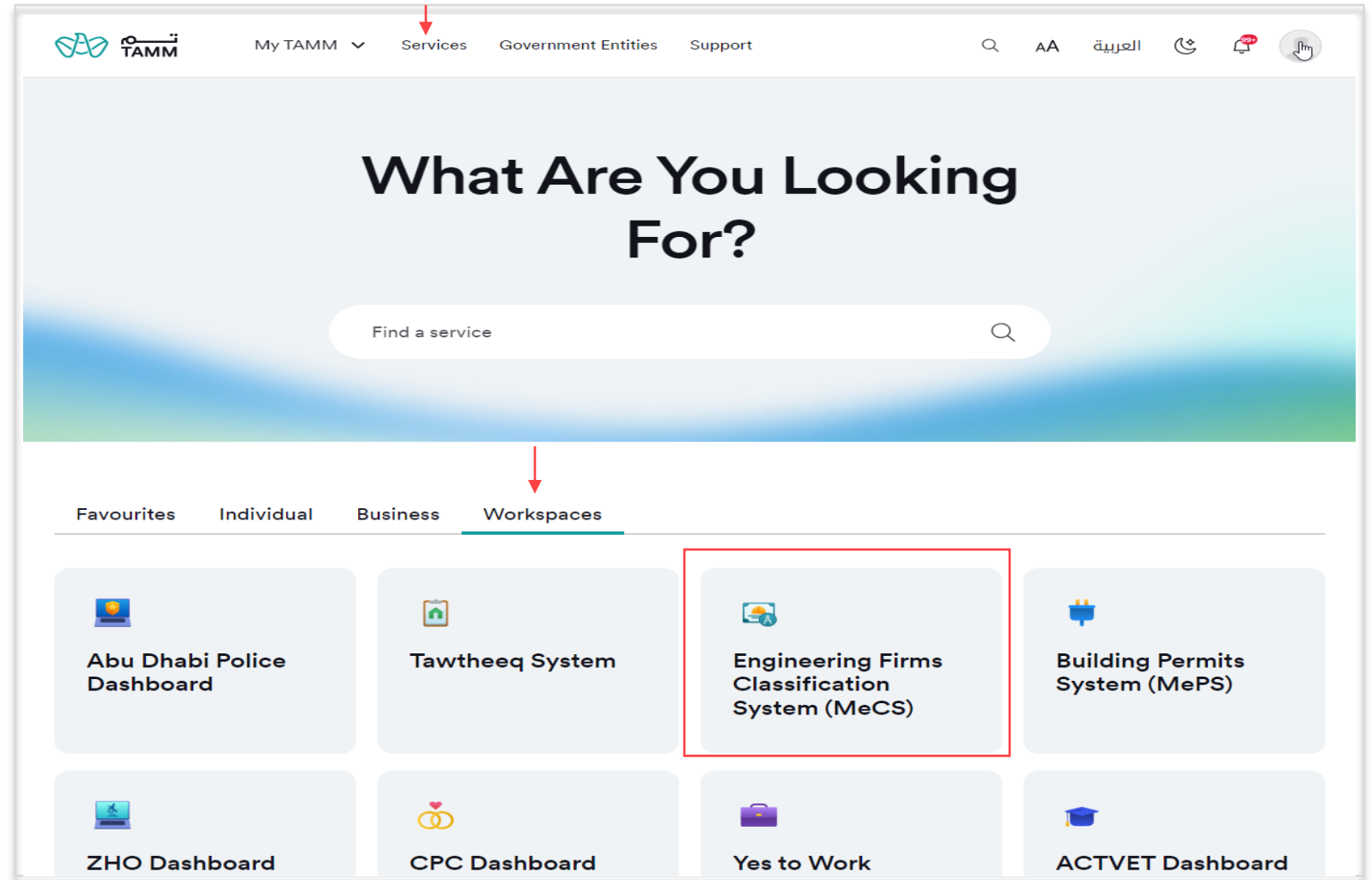

Dashboard

How to access the Dashboard

After accessing TAMM portal using UAE Pass, Go to **Services** then select **workspaces** . Scroll down and select “**Engineering Firms Classification System (MeCS)**” as shown in the figure and you will be directed to the next screen where you can choose the firm you need as you will see on the next page.





Upon selecting “**Engineering Firms Classification System (MeCS)**” from previous list, the user can select again the exact firm/account to be accessed as some accounts can be defined on more than one firm and therefore the user can switch between them.

Upon selecting the "Performance Evaluation" tab, a comprehensive overview of the Engineering Performance Evaluation and Excellence System is presented. This overview encompasses the following components:

1. Evaluation Period Selection: Users are afforded the ability to select a specific evaluation period from a list of calculated periods. The default selection is the most recent completed evaluation period. Following period selection, the corresponding evaluation result and a visual representation in the form of a star rating are displayed.

2. Evaluation Details: A detailed breakdown of the evaluation results for the chosen period is presented, encompassing all evaluation criteria.

3. Evaluation Certificates: Comprehensive evaluation certificates for each completed evaluation period are accessible for download. These certificates provide an in-depth analysis of the engineering firm's performance.
